Proclamation of State of Emergency***

Pursuant to Chapter 2, Article VI, "State of Emergency Provisions", The Carolina Beach Town Council has determined that a State of Emergency as defined in the Carolina Beach Code of Ordinances exists in Carolina Beach.

The Carolina Beach Town Council proclaims the existence of a State of Emergency in Carolina Beach due to the approaching Hurricane Isaias.

The Carolina Beach Town Council hereby orders all Town law enforcement officers and all personnel to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of the Town emergency ordinances, which are set forth below:

Evacuation. *A voluntary evacuation for non-residents is effective Monday, August 3, 2020 at 12:00 noon. It is recommended that everyone be in a safe place by 6:00 p.m.*

Execution of Emergency Plan. *All persons and emergency personnel within the Town of Carolina Beach are ordered to comply with the emergency plan.*

This proclamation shall become effective immediately.
