Auxiliary Stormwater Pump: Stormwater staff received a new auxiliary pump for the Greenville Avenue/Second Street pumpstation. This pump was paid for entirely by funding received through the American Rescue Plan Act. The emergency pump will provide diesel powered backup to the electric pump located at this stormwater pumpstation and will help reduce water that would flow to the Lake basin during power outages.


