Registrants will only be allowed to register each camper for 2 weeks. We are initially limiting the number of weeks per camper. If you register for more than 2 weeks, staff will void all your Summer Camp Registrations.

This will allow more community children the opportunity to experience an adventurous Carolina Beach Parks and Recreation Summer Camp!

Payment is not due upon registration. Staff will follow-up with each participant to ensure you only register for 2 weeks and we will confirm proof of residency if you register under a Carolina Beach Resident account.

Starting at Noon on Monday, April 17th, all remaining available camp weeks will be open to all participants. At this point, you can register for any remaining weeks. After camp weeks are full, please add your camper to our Wait List — we always have cancellations!

You will receive an invoice via email after staff have reviewed your registration. Upon receiving your invoice, you will have 5 days to pay your Summer Camp balance. This allows you the option to pay in-person using cash or check.

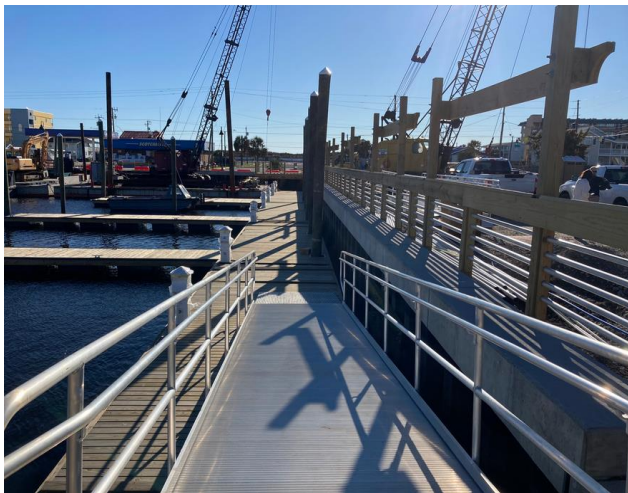
